*Genesis 18:1–14*

<sup>1</sup>The LORD appeared to Abraham by the oaks of Mamre, as he was sitting by the door to his tent during the heat of the day. <sup>2</sup>Abraham looked up, and he saw three men standing in front of him. When he saw them, he ran from the tent door to meet them, and he bowed down to the ground. <sup>3</sup>He said, "My lord, if I have now found favor in your sight, please do not pass your servant by. <sup>4</sup>Now let me get a little water so that all of you can wash your feet and rest under the tree. <sup>5</sup>Let me get some bread so that you can refresh yourselves. Our goal is that you please him by bearing fruit in every kind of good work and by growing in the knowledge of God, <sup>11</sup>as you are being strengthened with all power because of his glorious might working in you. Then you will have complete endurance and patience, joyfully <sup>12</sup>giving thanks to the Father, who qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light.

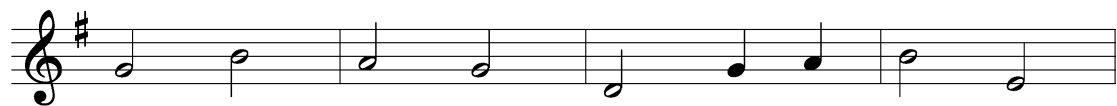
DISTRIBUTION
