

CONFESSION OF SIN & GOD'S PROMISE OF FORGIVENESS

- P: Holy and merciful God, we come to you this morning filled with joy from the resurrection of your Son, Jesus Christ. Yet in human weakness, our sinful behavior in the past week has proven that we need you desperately. Like David, we confess our sins with the words of Psalm 51:
- C: Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions. For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight. Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me. Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.
- P: Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again. In his great mercy, God made us alive in Christ even when we were dead in our sins. Hear the word of Christ through his called servant: all of your sins are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant a willing spirit to sustain me.
- P: Indeed "If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ not counting men's sins against them."

- C: Amen.


FIRST READING

Acts 13:26-38

²⁶ Brothers, children of Abraham, and you God-fearing Gentiles, it is to us that this message of salvation has been sent. ²⁷ The people of Jerusalem and their rulers did not recognize Jesus, yet in condemning him they fulfilled the words of the prophets that are read every Sabbath. ²⁸ Though they found no proper ground for a death sentence, they asked Pilate to have him executed. ²⁹ When they had carried out all that was written about him, they took him down from the tree and laid him in a tomb. ³⁰ But God raised him from the dead, ³¹ and for many days he was seen by those who had traveled with him from Galilee to Jerusalem. They are now his witnesses to our people. ³² "We tell you the good news: What God promised our fathers ³³ he has fulfilled for us, their children, by raising up Jesus. As it is written in the second Psalm: "You are my Son; today I have become your Father.' ³⁴ The fact that God raised him from the dead, never to decay, is stated in these words: "I will give you the holy and sure blessings promised to David.' ³⁵ So it is stated elsewhere: "You will not let your Holy One see decay.' ³⁶ "For when David had served God's purpose in his own generation, he fell asleep; he was buried with his fathers and his body decayed. ³⁷ But the one whom God raised from the dead did not see decay. ³⁸ "Therefore, my brothers, I want you to know that through Jesus the forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you.

GOSPEL READING

Luke 12:13-21

- ¹³ Someone in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me."
- ¹⁴ Jesus replied, "Man, who appointed me a judge or an arbiter between you?" ¹⁵ Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions."
- ¹⁶ And he told them this parable: "The ground of a certain rich man produced a good crop. ¹⁷ He thought to himself, 'What shall I do? I have no place to store my crops.'
- ¹⁸ "Then he said, 'This is what I'll do. I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. ¹⁹ And I'll say to myself, "You have plenty of good things laid up for many years. Take life easy; eat, drink and be merry."
- ²⁰ "But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?" ²¹ "This is how it will be with anyone who stores up things for himself but is not rich toward God."
- P: This is the Gospel of the Lord.
- C: Praise be to you, O Christ.

I believe in God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth.


I believe in Jesus Christ,
